2 CHAIRMAN SMITH: We will move to Item No. 4.
3 Mr. Sanchez, I believe you are introducing to the
4 item.

5 MR. SANCHEZ: Good morning, Commissioners.

6 Item No. 4 addresses Duke Energy Florida,
7 LLC's, petition for a solar base rate adjustment.
8 Paragraph 16 of the 2024 Duke Energy Settlement
9 Agreement allows for the inclusion into base rates
10 of up to 900 megawatts of solar generation. Duke
11 is seeking approval of four solar projects
12 collectively known as the Second SoBRA Tranche,
13 which consists of approximately 300 megawatts of
14 total installed capacity from the following solar
15 facilities: Jumper Creek in Sumter County;
16 Turnpike in Osceola County; Lonesome Camp in
17 Osceola County; and Banner in Columbia County.

18 The Commission's decision is limited based on
19 the 2024 settlement regarding the reasonableness
20 and cost-effectiveness of the solar generation
21 projects and the associated rate adjustment
22 calculations.

23 Staff recommends that the Commission approve
24 this petition and allow for the costs of these
25 solar projects to be included in base rates through

1 the SoBRA mechanism as Duke has shown they meet the
2 standards of the 2024 Settlement Agreement.

3 As part of its recommendation, staff also
4 requests administrative authority to approve
5 tariffs and associated charges for each of these
6 solar projects and that this docket should remain
7 open until the Commission receives a letter from
8 Duke confirming the commercial operation date of
9 each solar project.

10 Staff is available for any questions.

11 CHAIRMAN SMITH: Thank you.

12 Okay. Commissioners, we have heard a summary.
13 Is there any discussion?

14 I will take a motion then.

15 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Move to approve, Madam
16 Chair.

17 COMMISSIONER LA ROSA: Second.
