**TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY'S PETITION FOR APPROVAL OF
GENERATING PERFORMANCE INCENTIVE FACTOR RESULTS
FOR THE TWELVE-MONTH PERIOD ENDING DECEMBER 2025**

Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or "the company") hereby petitions this Commission for approval of the company's Generating Performance Incentive Factor ("GPIF") results for the twelve-month period ending December 2025. In support of this Petition, Tampa Electric states as follows:

1. By Order No. PSC-2024-0481-FOF-EI, dated November 22, 2024, the Commission approved Tampa Electric's GPIF targets for the period January 2025 through December 2025. The application of the GPIF formula to the performance of the company's GPIF units during that period produces a reward of \$7,622,180. The calculation of the company's GPIF reward is discussed and supported in the prepared direct testimony and exhibit of Tampa Electric witness Adam L. Parke, which are being filed together with this petition and incorporated herein by reference.

2. Tampa Electric is not aware of any disputed issues of material fact relative to the relief requested herein.

WHEREFORE, Tampa Electric respectfully requests the Commission to approve \$7,622,180 as its GPIF reward for the period ending December 2025 and authorize the inclusion of this amount in the calculation of Tampa Electric's fuel factors for the period beginning January 2027.
