We are customers of Sunshine Water Services Company residing in Seminole County.

While we understand that these applications state there will be no immediate rate impact, we are concerned about the long-term implications of continued system acquisitions and service area expansion.

Specifically, we are concerned about:

- The potential for future cost allocation across geographically distant service areas
- The establishment of rate base values that may later be used to justify system-wide rate increases
- The cumulative impact of these actions on existing customers who do not directly benefit from the acquired systems

We respectfully request that the Commission carefully evaluate how these acquisitions and related rate base determinations may affect customers across all service areas over time.
