I'm a customer of Sunshine Water Services here in Seminole County. I understand these applications say there won't be an immediate impact on our rates, but I do have concerns about what this could mean down the road.

My main concern is how these continued system acquisitions and expansion of service areas could eventually affect current customers. Specifically, I'm worried about costs being spread across areas that are not even close to each other, and customers like us possibly paying for systems we don't benefit from.

I'm also concerned that the rate base being set now could later be used to justify future rate increases across the system.

Overall, it's the long-term and cumulative impact of these decisions that concerns me most.

I respectfully ask the Commission to take a close look at how these actions could affect existing customers over time.
