Dear : Ms. Clark and Mr. Crabb:

By this letter, the Commission staff requests that CSWR-Florida Utility Operating Company (CSWR) provide responses to the following data requests:

1. Please refer to CSWR's response to Staff's Second Data Request, numbers 1 and 2, attachments DR 1.1 – Completed Projects Support – AQ and DR 2.1 – Long Term Options Support – AQ.
 - a. Please explain why there are two projects listed for the tanks/hydropneumatic tank (water) that were completed on August 1, 2024, and why there is a difference in costs.
 - b. Please explain why there are two projects listed for the aeration system/blowers and aeration piping (sewer) that were completed on August 1, 2024, and why there is a difference in costs.
 - c. Please explain why there are two projects listed for the electrical and monitoring systems/electrical and control systems (sewer) that were completed on April 1, 2024, and why there is a difference in costs.

- d. Please explain why there are two projects listed for the electrical and monitoring systems/electrical and control systems (sewer) that were completed on August 1, 2024, and why there is a difference in costs.
 - e. For the wastewater system, the completed Safety Equipment projects appear to be completed on the same dates and for the same costs as the Disinfection Systems projects. Are these projects the same?
2. Please refer to CSWR's response to Staff's Second Data Request, number 2. Please provide estimated in-service dates and estimated costs for the New Monitoring Well, Safety Grating and Catwalks, New Headworks, Shade Structure, Cover for Clarifier, and Sand Filter projects.
 3. Please refer to CSWR's response to Staff's Second Data Request, number 2, attachment DR 2.1 – Long Term Options Support – AQ. The projects listed on the attachment appear to have been completed. Are these ongoing projects? If so, when will future projects occur, and what are the estimated costs?
