PETITION OF TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY

Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or "the company"), hereby petitions the Commission for approval of the company's environmental cost recovery true-up amount of \$1,488,013 over-recovery for the twelve-month period ending December 2025. In support of thereof, says:

Environmental Cost Recovery

1. Tampa Electric's final true-up amount for the period January 2025 through December 2025 is an over-recovery of \$1,488,013. [See Exhibit No. ____ (ZJP-1), Document No. 1 (Schedule 42-1A).]

2. By Order No. PSC-2025-0437-FOF-EI, the Commission approved environmental cost recovery factors for the period commencing January 2026. These factors reflected an actual/estimated true-up over-recovery, including interest, for the period January 2025 through December 2025 of \$467,965 which was also approved in Order No. PSC-2025-0437-FOF-EI. The actual over-recovery, including interest, for the period January 2025 through December 2025 is \$1,955,978. The \$1,955,978 actual over-recovery, less the estimated over-recovery of \$467,965 which is currently reflected in charges for the twelve-month period beginning January 2026, results in a net environmental cost recovery true-up over-recovery of \$1,488,013 that is to be included in the calculation of the environmental cost recovery factors for the period beginning January 2027.

3. For reasons more fully detailed in the Prepared Direct Testimony of witness Zel Jones-Phillips, the environmental compliance costs sought to be approved for cost recovery proposed in this petition are consistent with the provisions of Section 366.8255, Florida Statutes, and with prior rulings by the Commission with respect to environmental compliance cost recovery for Tampa Electric and other investor-owned utilities.

WHEREFORE, Tampa Electric Company requests the Commission to approve the company's environmental cost recovery true-up over-recovery amount of \$1,488,013 and authorize the inclusion of this amount in the calculation of the environmental cost recovery factors for the period beginning January 2027.
