

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- 3) Consistent with the requirements for this proceeding, the Company has prefiled the SPPCRC true-up forms supplied by the Commission consistent with the requirements for such filings.
- 4) With this Petition, the Company is also submitting the Direct Testimony and Exhibit AR-1 of Ms. Alison Regan in support of the Company's request for approval of the final true-up amount, as well as the Testimony of P. Mark Cutshaw.
- 5) The final remaining true-up amount for the period ended December 2025 is an over-recovery of \$225,624 reflecting an actual, end of period under recovery of \$1,291,805 as compared to the Company's projected under-recovery of \$1,517,429 for 2025, as reflected in Order No. PSC-2025-0439-PFO-EI, issued November 24, 2025, and utilized in the calculation of FPUC's 2026 SPPCRC cost recovery factors.
- 6) The Company now therefore seeks approval to include the final remaining true-up amount, which is an over-recovery of \$225,624, in the calculation of cost recovery factors for the period beginning January 2027.

WHEREFORE, FPUC respectfully requests that the Commission approve the Company's final net true-up amount for the period ended December 2025 as set forth above.
