**TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY'S PETITION FOR APPROVAL OF FUEL
AND CAPACITY COST RECOVERY NET TRUE-UPS AND
ASSET OPTIMIZATION MECHANISM RESULTS FOR THE
TWELVE-MONTH PERIOD ENDING DECEMBER 2025**

Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or "the company"), hereby petitions the Commission for approval of the company's net fuel and purchased power true-up under-recovery amount of \$3,724,857, net capacity true-up under-recovery amount of \$3,395,157, and Tampa Electric's Asset Optimization Mechanism incentive in the amount of \$9,772,290, for the twelve-month period ending December 2025. In support of this Petition, states as follows:

1. The \$3,724,857, net fuel and purchased power true-up under-recovery for the period January 2025 through December 2025 was calculated in accordance with the methodology set forth in Schedule 1, page 2 of 2, attached to Order No. 10093, dated June 19, 1981. This calculation and the supporting documentation are contained in the prepared testimony and exhibit of Tampa Electric witness Zel Jones-Phillips, which are being filed together with this Petition and are incorporated herein by reference.

2. By Order No. PSC-2025-0436-FOF-EI, issued on November 24, 2025, the Commission approved fuel factors for the period commencing January 2026. These factors reflected an actual/estimate true-up over-recovery, including interest, for the period January 2025 through December 2025 of \$14,653,914. The actual over-recovery, including interest, for the period January 2025 through December 2025 is \$10,929,057. The \$10,929,057,

actual over-recovery, minus the estimated over-recovery of \$14,653,914, results in a net fuel true-up under-recovery of \$3,724,857, that is to be included in the calculation of the fuel factors for the period beginning January 2027.

3. The \$3,395,157, net capacity true-up under-recovery amount for the period January 2025 through December 2025 was calculated in accordance with the methodology set forth in Order No. 25773, dated February 24, 1992. This calculation and the supporting documentation are contained in the prepared direct testimony and exhibit of Tampa Electric witness Zel Jones-Phillips.

4. By Order No. PSC-2017-0456-S-EI, issued November 27, 2017, in Docket Nos. 20170210-EI and 20160160-EI, the Commission approved the company's Asset Optimization Mechanism for a four year term beginning January 1, 2018 with the following sharing thresholds: (a) up to \$4.5 million per year, 100% of the gain is allocated to customers; (b) greater than \$4.5 million per year and less than \$8 million per year, 60% is allocated to shareholders and 40% is allocated to customers; and (c) greater than \$8.0 million per year, 50% allocated to shareholders and 50% allocated to customers. The Commission extended the company's existing Asset Optimization mechanism through Order No. PSC-2025-0038-FOF-EI, issued on February 03, 2025. The calculation and supporting documentation for the Asset Optimization Mechanism results are contained in the prepared testimony and exhibit of Tampa Electric witness John C. Heisey, which are being filed together with this Petition and are incorporated herein by reference. Tampa Electric's share of the incremental gains is \$9,772,290, which is to be included in the calculation of the Fuel Cost Recovery Factors for the period beginning January 2027.

WHEREFORE, Tampa Electric Company respectfully requests the Commission to approve the company's net fuel true-up under-recovery amount of \$3,724,857, Asset

Optimization Mechanism incentive sharing amount of \$9,772,290, and authorize the inclusion of these amounts in the calculation of the fuel factors for the period beginning January 2027; and to approve Tampa Electric's net capacity true-up under-recovery amount of \$3,395,157, and authorize the inclusion of this amount in the calculation of the capacity factors for the period beginning January 2027.
