**TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY'S  
REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION**

Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or the "company"), pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, hereby requests confidential classification of certain highlighted information contained in the exhibit of Tampa Electric witness John C. Heisey (Bates stamp page 12) for the period January 2025 – December 2025. In support thereof, the company says:

1. Along with this Request, Tampa Electric is providing, on a confidential basis, a single copy of Asset Optimization Results Table 5 (Bates Stamp page 12) of the Exhibit JCH-1 of Tampa Electric witness John C. Heisey, consisting of a one-page spreadsheet entitled "Tampa Electric Asset Optimization Detail – Table 5." Bates Stamp Page 12 contains certain information ("Confidential information") highlighted in yellow. The Confidential Information is highlighted in yellow in columns (2) through (5).

2. Subsection 366.093(1), Florida Statutes, provides that any records "found by the Commission to be proprietary confidential business information shall be kept confidential and shall be exempt from s.119.07(1) [requiring disclosure under the Public Records Act]." The proprietary confidential business information includes, but is not limited to:

(d) Information concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the public utility or its affiliates to contract for goods

or services on favorable terms. (Section 366.093(3)(d), Florida Statutes)

3. Proprietary confidential business information also includes:

(e) Information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information. (Section 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes)

4. The Confidential Information falls within the above statutory categories and, thus, constitutes proprietary confidential business information entitled to protection under Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Adm. The exhibit contains details regarding asset optimization activities and discloses details of Tampa Electric's competitive and strategic approaches to asset optimization. The disclosure of this information would be harmful to competitive interests, and as such, the information is entitled to confidential treatment pursuant to Section 366.093(d) and (e), Florida Statutes and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code.

5. Tampa Electric treats the Confidential Information as such and has not disclosed it publicly.

WHEREFORE, Tampa Electric Company respectfully requests that the yellow highlighted Confidential Information contained in witness John C. Heisey's Exhibit JCH-1 (Bates stamp page 12), for the period January 2026 through December 2026 be afforded confidential classification for the reasons set forth above.
