**Issue 2:** Should the Commission approve Citrus Waterworks, Inc.’s application to amend Certificate No. 684-W to extend its service territory in Citrus County?

**Recommendation:** Yes. The Commission should amend Certificate No. 684-W to include the territory described in Attachment A of staff’s memorandum dated March 26, 2026, effective the date of the Commission’s vote. The resultant order should serve as Citrus’ amended certificate and should be retained by the Utility. Citrus should continue to charge customers in the amended service territory the rates and charges contained in the Utility’s current tariff until a change is authorized by the Commission in a subsequent proceeding.
