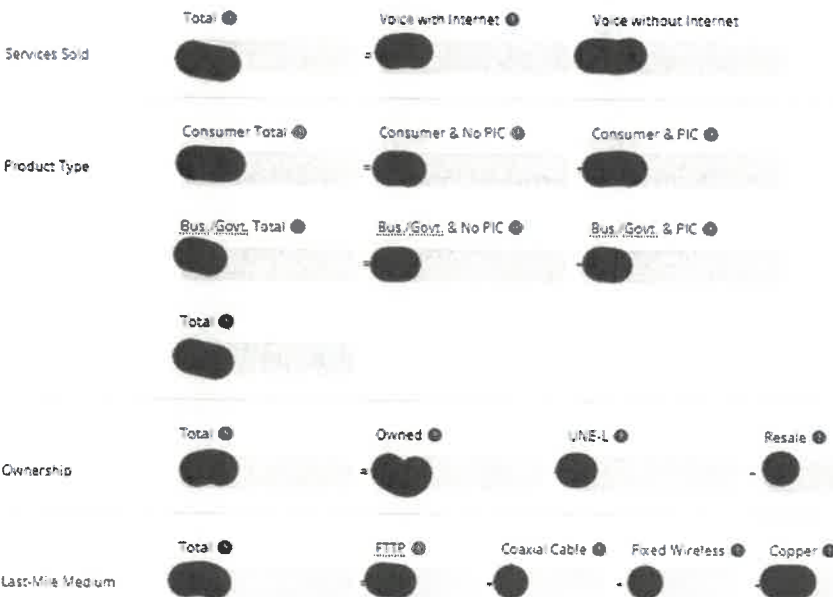
Allocate Lines Provided to Unaffiliated Providers

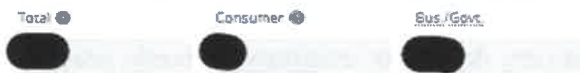
