Dear Mr. Teitzman:

In accordance with Order No. PSC-2023-0177-FOF-GU, Florida City Gas (FCG) submits this letter regarding the status of its Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) Pilot Program.

The Florida Public Service Commission (Commission) approved the AMI Pilot Program to enable FCG to gather information and determine the feasibility of AMI technology on its system and appropriateness of system-wide deployment of the technology in the future. The Commission required FCG to provide a final report with a summary of the findings as to the feasibility of the AMI Program, its appropriateness for system-wide deployment and the resulting cost savings to the customers within 90 days of the completion of the AMI Pilot.

On December 1, 2023, Chesapeake Utilities Corporation (CUC or Chesapeake) completed the acquisition of FCG from Florida Power and Light (FPL). With this acquisition, the AMI Pilot, as approved by the Commission, could not be completed because, as reflected in Order No. PSC-2023-0177-FOF-GU, FCG had planned to use FPL's radio frequency network to facilitate communication with the AMI meters, which is no longer an available option. However, FCG did purchase the 5000 meters approved as part of the pilot program by the Commission and has installed them. FCG will be seeking Commission approval of alternative AMI technology to facilitate implementation of AMI in a future filing.
