STAFF'S SECOND DATA REQUEST REGARDING DEF'S PETITION FOR APPROVAL
OF AMENDED STANDARD OFFER CONTRACT (SCHEDULE COG-2)**

1. Refer to DEF's 2026 Ten-Year Site Plan, Schedules 8 and 9 (Revised). Please explain why the 2031 Combustion Turbines are not eligible to be selected as the next avoidable generating units pursuant to 25-17.250(2), Florida Administrative Code.

RESPONSE:

The 2031 Combustion Turbines do not qualify as avoidable units because DEF has taken steps to begin construction. Specifically, DEF has entered into purchase contracts for major equipment, the Combustion Turbines, which have significant financial penalties for cancellation and require progress payments beginning in 2Q 2026.
