1 **Q. Please state your name and business address.**

2 A. Allysha Fischbacher, 1635 Meathe Drive, West Palm Beach, FL, 33411

3 **Q. By whom are you employed and in what capacity?**

4 A. I am employed by Chesapeake Utilities Corporation (“CUC”) as Regulatory
5 Analyst. Chesapeake Utilities is the parent company of Florida Public Utilities
6 Company (“FPUC”) and Florida City Gas (“FCG”), (herein referred to jointly as
7 the “Companies”).

8 **Q. Briefly state your education background and employment experience.**

9 A. I received a bachelor’s degree in finance from Benedict College. After graduation, I
10 worked as an Associate Financial Analyst at Dominion Energy. In December 2024, I
11 joined CUC in the Regulatory Department, where my responsibilities include
12 preparing various filings such as Purchased Gas Adjustment, Docket No. 20260003-
13 GU before the Florida Public Service Commission.

14 **Q. Have you testified before this or any other Commission?**

15 A. No.

16 **Q. What is the purpose of your testimony at this time?**

1 A. To advise the Commission of the Companies consolidated actual over/under
2 recovery of the Purchased Gas Adjustment for the period January 1, 2025,
3 through December 31, 2025, as compared to the consolidated true-up amount
4 previously reported for that period which was based on six months actual and
5 six months estimated.

6 **Q. Please state the actual consolidated amount of over/under recovery of the**
7 **Purchased Gas Adjustment for January 1, 2025, through December 31,**
8 **2025.**

9 A. During January 2025 through December 2025, the Companies under-recovered
10 \$4,056,838.

11 **Q. How does this amount compare with the estimated consolidated true-up**
12 **amount, which was allowed by the Commission during the November 2025**
13 **hearing?**

14 A. As recognized in Order No. PSC-2025-0432-FOF-GU, in Docket No.
15 20250003-GU, the Companies had an anticipated over-recovery of \$1,318,472
16 based upon six months of actual and six months of projected data.

17 **Q. Have you prepared any exhibits at this time?**

18 A. I prepared and pre-filed composite Exhibit AF-1, containing Schedule A-7,
19 Final PGA Over/Under Recovery for the Period January 2025 through
20 December 2025.

21 **Q. Does this conclude your testimony?**

22 A. Yes.
