Applicant Narrative of Business and Public Necessity and Convenience of CLEC Certification

GENIOX US LLC is a Florida telecommunications and technology company organized and operating and engaged in the business of providing advanced data and wireless internet connection services, wireless mobile communications, and related technology solutions to government, commercial customers and business to consumer providers within the State of Florida (“GENIOX”). GENIOX’ customer and client base focuses on three primary clientele:

1. **Broadcasters** (traditional mass media and online streaming providers of content) who utilize GENIOX wireless internet connection and wireless services for remote coverage, live streaming video, and connection to transmission points, particularly remote locations.
2. **Maritime Businesses** who utilize GENIOX wireless internet connection for their IOT and logistical coordination, including point to point wireless connection in combination with facilities.
3. **Cruise Line Industry** utilize GENIOX services with their guests to offer distribution on data services on-board vessels in combination with ship to shore data services.
4. **Business & NGO Customers** including businesses in transport, shipping, logistics, and were remote Teams of personnel are deployed.
