Request for Confidential Classification for Document No. 03245-2026

On May 29, 2026, Duke Energy Florida, LLC (DEF or Company) filed a request for confidential classification for Document No. 03245-2026. This document contains certain confidential information provided in response to Office of Public Counsel's First Set of Production of Documents (Nos. 1-4), specifically question 3 related to internal guidelines, planning strategies, and financial information.

In its request for confidentiality, DEF asserts that disclosure of this information would harm DEF, as the information relates to proprietary confidential business information. Furthermore, DEF states that absent the confidential classification, competitors would have access to this proprietary confidential business information.

Staff has reviewed the documents and concurs with DEF that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would impair its competitive business interests. Therefore, staff recommends the request for confidential classification of DEF's response to Office of Public Counsel's First Set of Production of Documents (Nos. 1-4), specifically question 3 be approved.
