Pursuant to Order No. PSC-2026-0034-PCO-EI, Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") files this letter to report that, at this time, it anticipates petitioning the Commission for approval of the following three new projects as eligible for recovery through the Environmental Cost Recovery Clause ("ECRC") in this proceeding:

1. Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS) Project – The purpose of this new project is to facilitate compliance with PFAS testing requirements set forth in 40 CFR Parts 141 and 142, as well as control requirements set forth in Florida Laws Chapter 2026-158, which takes effect on July 1, 2026, and 40 CFR Part 302. FPL's preliminary estimate of the costs associated with compliance activities is approximately \$24,000 in 2026, with costs potentially increasing in future years as compliance needs are further determined.
2. Little Manatee River Minimum Flow Level Compliance Project – The purpose of this new project is to facilitate the FPL Manatee Plant's compliance with a required minimum water flow level set by the Southwest Florida Water Management District for the Little Manatee River, which is anticipated to become effective with a renewed site certification for the Manatee Plant in the third quarter of 2026. FPL's preliminary estimate of the costs associated with compliance activities is approximately \$1.2 million in 2026 and \$300,000 in 2027.

3. FPL Eagle Permit Compliance Project – The purpose of this new project is to implement an eagle incidental take permit program and undertake related compliance activities consistent with the requirements of 50 CFR Part 22 (Subpart E). FPL's preliminary estimate of the costs associated with compliance activities is approximately \$70,000 in 2026 and \$260,000 in 2027.

The costs noted above for each project are preliminary estimates. FPL is continuing to develop the scope of compliance of activities and the associated costs. FPL plans to provide by separate filing more developed descriptions regarding FPL's projected compliance activities and updated estimates of the related costs.
