We are a seventy year old couple who bought a 1992 mobile home in Buttonwood Bay in 2021, at 332 Sebring Drive, Sebring, Florida, 33875.

The water situation in Buttonwood Bay has been a constant concern. In the past five years of this being our home, we have had more water boil orders (meaning tap water is unsafe to drink!) than we have experienced in our entire lives! So often do we have official notice NOT to drink water out of the faucet that we NEVER take a chance with our health to drink it. We have to bring safe drinking water into our home every week.

We do, however use the Utility for household necessities, laundry, and outdoor watering as required. So we are doubly concerned that this already poor water and sewer situation may cost more in the future if you approve the subject request. Please do not allow a rate increase.

We appreciate your diligence in taking our Objection seriously.
