Dear Commissioners of the Florida Public Service Commission,

I am writing to express my disgust at the massive, rate increases proposed by Florida City Gas (FCG) under Docket No. 20260026-GU.

Receiving a notice tonight that our bills will practically double just days before the Commission votes on July 7 is a complete slap in the face to consumers. Forcing a spike of this magnitude onto captive customers at the absolute eleventh hour, with zero reasonable warning, is predatory.

As shown in the official utility chart, the sudden jumps for regular residential families are staggering:

RS-100 Customers: The fixed monthly charge spikes from \$19.00 to \$25.00, while the usage rate skyrockets from \$0.57421 to \$0.91517 per therm (a 59.3% increase).

RS-1 Customers: The usage rate surges from \$0.67667 to \$0.91507 per therm.

Doubling our rates in one single shot with no notice is irresponsible. The PSC's job is to protect Florida citizens, not rubber-stamp monopoly corporate greed. I strongly urge the Commission to vote NO on this rate increase on July 7.
