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To Whom It May Concern,

My name is Alec Whitaker and I am a resident of Indialantic, Florida. I am writing to you today to voice my **staunch opposition** to this wholly unnecessary and **massive** rate increase proposed by Florida City Gas. This increase is a **more than 50% increase** on natural gas rates for Florida homeowners (RS-100) during a time when Florida homeowners are barely getting by. Property taxes have gone through the roof the last several years. Home insurance rates have multiplied by four. Food, gas, and other essentials have more than doubled.

Florida City Gas is pursuing this increase solely to increase revenues, and that is not an acceptable reason to burden Florida homeowners with an **astronomical rate increase** on such a critical utility.

I respectfully request that the commission **deny this rate increase** in its current form. This rate increase is completely unreasonable and must be reworked to fall within reason.
