On July 8, 2026, SeaCoast Gas Transmission (SeaCoast) filed a request for confidential classification of Document No. 04003-2026. Document No. 04003-2026 contains certain information in the proposed transportation service agreement with People's Gas System (PGS), which SeaCoast identified as confidential. Specifically, SeaCoast identified the cost relating to constructing/installing new 8-inch steel pipeline on page 3. Furthermore, SeaCoast explained in its request for confidential classification that both SeaCoast and PGS treat the information as proprietary confidential business information that is not otherwise available in the public domain.

Staff has reviewed the document and concurs with SeaCoast that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Sections 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would harm the competitive business operations of SeaCoast. Therefore, staff recommends that the request by SeaCoast for confidential classification of Document No. 04003-2026 be approved.
