DECREASE PENALTY RIDER

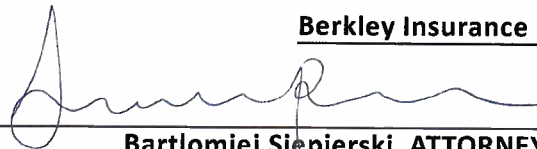
