Comment: I, Robert Stanionis, have lived full time in Buttonwood Bay since 2019 and as a snowbird for 3 years prior. During that time, we experience many issues with the water that required us to boil before use. Also, we would lose water totally or the water pressure would drop to an unusable level on a regular basis. There were even times when the water was actually brown in color. Most people refuse to drink the water to this day. I only drink it now because I have a water softener and a filtering system. These issues were the norm up until about a year ago when maintenance finally made the investment to properly repair the problems.

The investment that was made only provided for us what we were already paying for, and cannot be considered an improvement. We lived with substandard water for so long and were forced to pay for it. Having properly repaired this issue was the duty and obligation of Sun Communities and not a benefit to its population. Therefore, I believe there should be no consideration for reimbursement of the investment Sun Communities made, and only reasonable increase in the rate based on current costs.
