I believe we need no increase in our utilities! I have lived in Buttonwood Bay for 12 years and the water has not been up to my standards. I have bought drinking water and cooking water for 12 years. The water in Buttonwood Bay is not acceptable for me to drink! I take showers with it, and that's about it!

Please do not raise that utility rates for that water and that sewage!

Last year, I believe we only used less than 4000 gallons of water each month that we were there. We are usually there only four months out of the 12 month year. But we still have to pay utilities on water and sewage the other eight months when we're not there!

I do not think raising the utilities is a fair thing to do! I would rather be on Sebring city water!
