We have lived in Buttonwood Bay for 12 years. We have never used the water in Buttonwood Bay as drinking water or cooking water! We go elsewhere to get water or buy water for drinking and cooking. We do take a shower with Buttonwood, water, but that's about it.

We are in Buttonwood, about 4 months out of every 12 months. But we pay water and sewage bills all 12 months.

I wish we were on Sebring city water.

We do not believe a water increase is necessary! Last season I believe our water usage was less than 4000 gallons monthly for the four months that we were in Buttonwood Bay. The other eight months there was zero use and 0 gallons used for eight months.

Please consider no rate increase!
