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FCG is requesting rates that increase the RS-100 distribution charge by 62% and the customer charge by 52% not the 24.29% stated in their Notice.

In effect they want the current customers to fund their expansion plans (a 24 inch pipeline in the south of the state). Normal large expansion plans are financed by debt not current customer charges who will receive no future benefit from the expansion.
