

FAR NOTICE OF HEARING

PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

The FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION announces a hearing in the following dockets to which all persons are invited.

HEARING DATE AND TIME: Tuesday, August 4, 2026, immediately following the 9:30 Agenda Conference.

PLACE: Room 148, Betty Easley Conference Center, 4075 Esplanade Way, Tallahassee, Florida.

DOCKET NOS. AND TITLES: 20260053-EI - Review of the 2024-2025 outage of Tampa Electric Company's Bayside Steam Turbine Unit 2, 20260001-EI - Fuel and purchased power cost recovery clause with generating performance incentive factor, and 20260062-EI - Petition for approval of revised depreciation rates for Bayside Power Station assets, by Tampa Electric Company.

GENERAL SUBJECT MATTER TO BE CONSIDERED AT THE HEARING:

The purpose of this hearing shall be to receive testimony and exhibits and to take final action relative to the 2026 Bayside Agreement (Stipulation and Settlement Agreement dated June 12, 2026) which resolves replacement power issues for the Bayside Steam Turbine Unit 2 and the Bayside Combustion Turbine 2D and revisions to the depreciation rates for the Bayside Power Station. Additionally, the Commission shall take action on any motions or other matters that may be pending at the time of the hearing. The Commission may rule on any such motions from the bench or may take the matters under advisement. This proceeding shall: (1) allow the parties to present evidence and testimony in support of their positions; (2) allow for such other purposes as the Commission may deem appropriate.
