Comment: Dear Commissioners,

I am a residential customer of Florida City Gas and I strongly oppose the proposed rate increase in Docket No. 20260026-GU.

We already had a rate increase this year, and now the company is requesting another significant hike that would raise my monthly bill by approximately \$13.57 (24.29%). I believe this increase is excessive and constitutes an abuse toward customers.

Families are already struggling with high inflation and rising costs in housing, food, and other essentials. Another increase in natural gas makes it very difficult to keep up with payments.

While I understand the company has expenses, it is not fair to continuously pass those costs onto customers. They should find more efficiencies and internal savings, especially after the acquisition by Chesapeake Utilities.

I respectfully request that the Commission ****deny or significantly reduce**** this rate increase to protect residential customers.
