1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 CHAIRMAN SMITH: We are moving to Item No. 5.

3 MS. HOLLOWAY: Good afternoon. I am Aiyana
4 Holloway with the Division of Accounting and
5 Finance.

6 Item 5 is staff's recommendation on Florida
7 Power & Light's request for approval of the actual
8 storm costs associated with Hurricane Debby, Helene
9 and Milton, the associated true-up process and a
10 joint stipulations filed on June 18th, 2026 by the
11 Office of Public Counsel and Florida Power & Light.

12 On December 19th, 2025, FPL filed a petition
13 for a limited proceedings seeking approval of the
14 actual recoverable storm restoration costs in the
15 amount of 1.25 billion, and to approve the process
16 for any over or underrecovery of the interim storm
17 cost surcharge.

18 This item is a follow-up to the order filed on
19 December 17th, 2024, where the Commission approved
20 FPL's interim storm cost recovery surcharge and
21 left the docket open pending the reconciliation of
22 the actual recoverable storm costs in the amount
23 collected through to the interim cost recovery
24 surcharge.

25 On December 19th, 2025, FPL filed a petition

1 and testimony to reflect the actual storm costs
2 incurred by the 2024 hurricanes, and on February
3 13th, 2026, FPL filed supplemental testimony to
4 confirm the total amount collected through the
5 storm cost recovery surcharge.

6 There are 34 consumer comments in the
7 correspondence file. Representatives from the
8 Office of Public Counsel and FPL are in attendance
9 to answer any questions, in addition to staff.

10 Thank you.

11 CHAIRMAN SMITH: Thank you.

12 Commissioners, is there questions on Item 5?
13 Seeing none, I will take a motion then.

14 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Move staff, Madam Chair.

15 COMMISSIONER LA ROSA: Second.
