2 CHAIRMAN SMITH: Move to Item No. 9.

3 MR. NGUYEN: Good afternoon, Chairman and
4 Commissioners. Chris Nguyen with the Division of
5 Economics.

6 Item 9 is a petition by Duke Energy Florida
7 for the approval of modifications to its
8 underground residential distribution tariffs and
9 associated charges. These tariffs apply to
10 residential subdivisions and represent the
11 additional costs, if any, DEF incurs to provide
12 underground distribution service in place of
13 overhead service.

14 Duke's proposed differential charges remain
15 zero for low density subdivision models, and are
16 proposed to change from \$332 to zero for high
17 density subdivision models.

18 Based on staff's review of Duke's responses
19 and petition, staff believes the proposed charges
20 are cost-based and recommends approval of the
21 tariffs as filed.
