2 CHAIRMAN SMITH: Moving to Item No. 11. Mr.
3 Ward.

4 MR. WARD: Good afternoon, Commissioners.
5 Oakley Ward with the Division of Economics.

6 Item 11 is a petition by Florida Power & Light
7 Company for approval of revisions to its
8 underground residential differential tariff,
9 underground commercial differential tariff and
10 contribution in aid of construction tariffs.

11 The underground residential differential
12 tariff applies to new residential subdivisions, and
13 represent the additional costs, if any, FPL incurs
14 to provide underground distribution service in
15 place of overhead service. FPL's proposed
16 differential charges remain zero for low density,
17 high density and meter pedestal subdivision models.

18 Additionally, FPL is proposing revisions to
19 its contribution in aid of construction tariffs.
20 Specifically, FPL is seeking Commission approval to
21 revise certain aspects of its contribution in aid
22 of construction tariff provisions to provide better
23 clarity to customers requesting facilities and
24 equipment that are not usual and customary for the
25 type of installation to be served, as well as to

1 update the deposit required to prepare bonding cost
2 estimate for underground service.

3 Staff believes that the proposed tariffs are
4 reasonable and recommends approval.

5 CHAIRMAN LA ROSA: Thank you.

6 Do we have any questions on Item 11?

8 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Move approval.

9 COMMISSIONER LA ROSA: Second.
