

FAR NOTICE OF PREHEARING AND HEARING

PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

The FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION announces a prehearing conference and a hearing in the following dockets to which all persons are invited.

DOCKET NO. AND TITLE:

Docket No. 20260010-EI – Storm Protection Plan Cost Recovery Clause.

Docket No. 20260011-GU – Natural Gas Facilities Relocation Cost Recovery Clause.

PREHEARING CONFERENCE DATE AND TIME: Thursday, August 27, 2026, at 9:30 a.m.

PLACE: Room 148, Betty Easley Conference Center, 4075 Esplanade Way, Tallahassee, Florida.

GENERAL SUBJECT MATTER TO BE CONSIDERED AT THE PREHEARING:

The purpose of this prehearing conference is to: (1) simplify the issues; (2) identify the positions of the parties on the issues; (3) consider the possibility of obtaining admissions of fact and of documents which will avoid unnecessary proof; (4) identify exhibits; (5) establish an order of witnesses; and (6) consider such other matters as may aid in the disposition of the action.

HEARING DATE AND TIME: Tuesday, September 15, 2026, immediately following the Internal Affairs meeting which commences at 9:30 a.m. September 16–17, 2026, have also been reserved for continuation of the hearing if needed. The starting time of the next day's session will be announced at the conclusion of the prior day. The hearing may be adjourned early if all testimony is concluded.

PLACE: Room 148, Betty Easley Conference Center, 4075 Esplanade Way, Tallahassee, Florida.

GENERAL SUBJECT MATTER TO BE CONSIDERED AT THE HEARING:

The purpose of this hearing shall be to receive testimony and exhibits and to take final action relative to issues and subjects including, but not limited to, the following:

1. Determination of the projected Storm Protection Plan jurisdictional cost recovery amounts for the period January 2027 through December 2027.
2. Determination of the actual/estimated Storm Protection Plan jurisdictional cost recovery true-up amounts for the period January 2026 through December 2026.
3. Determination of the final Storm Protection Plan jurisdictional cost recovery true-up amounts for the period January 2025 through December 2025.
4. Determination of the natural gas facilities relocation projects and associated costs that are eligible for recovery through the Natural Gas Facilities Relocation Cost Recovery Clause.
5. Determination of the reasonably projected 2027 costs and projected revenue requirement amounts for the Natural Gas Facilities Relocation Cost Recovery Clause.
6. Determination of the reasonably estimated 2026 costs and estimated true-up revenue requirement amounts for the Natural Gas Facilities Relocation Cost Recovery Clause.
7. Determination of final prudently incurred costs and final true-up revenue requirement amounts for the Natural Gas Facilities Relocation Cost Recovery Clause for the period July 2024 through December 2025.

The purpose of this hearing is also to consider any motions or other matters that may be pending at the time of the hearing. The Commission may rule on any such motions from the bench or may take the matters under advisement. This proceeding shall: (1) allow the parties to present evidence and testimony in support of their positions; and (2) allow for such other purposes as the Commission may deem appropriate.

All witnesses shall be subject to cross-examination at the conclusion of their testimony. The hearing will be governed by the provisions of Chapters 120 and 366, Florida Statutes, and Chapters 25-22 and 28-106, Florida Administrative Code, and Rules 25-6.031 and 25-7.150, Florida Administrative Code.
