Comment: Here's some facts.

In April 2024 my total gas bill was approx \$42 for 10.6 Therms of gas.

In April 2026 my total gas bill was approx \$59 for 10.6 Therms of gas.

That's a 40 Percent increase.

The proposed upcoming increase would change the RS-1 residential rate per Therm from \$0.677 to \$1.4. That's over 100 percent increase for the gas cost which would increase the total bill by almost \$8.00.

That's around another 15 percent increase resulting in a total bill of \$67 for 10.6 Therms.

The result is an overall 60 Percent increase in a little over 2 years from April 2024.
