Comment: I am opposed to any rate increase for Florida City Gas.

The acquisition and consolidation of Florida City Gas by Netera (as well as the acquisitions in 2023) were supposed to lower costs. Instead it created a monopoly that lives to increase its profits via rate increase.

Currently, the ill thought out war in Iran is causing gasoline and oil rates to sky rocket. Not so with natural gas. It is mainly harvested domestically. In fact, with the introduction of fracking several years ago, natural gas has gotten much cheaper.

To ask for a 22% increase in the Distribution charge along with a 100% increase in the Customer charge (factoring in the loss of "SAFE") is nothing more than unjustified greed. Compared to other utilities, natural gas has very low maintenance costs. With underground placement, they are immune from the hurricane costly hurricane damage that plague other utilities.
