**PETITION OF PEOPLES GAS SYSTEM, INC.
FOR APPROVAL OF TRUE-UP AMOUNT AND COST RECOVERY FACTORS**

Peoples Gas System, Inc. ("Peoples" or the "company"), by and through its undersigned counsel files this Petition for approval of the company's conservation cost recovery true-up and the cost recovery factors proposed for use during the period January through December 2027, and in support thereof, states:

Introduction

1. Peoples is a natural gas local distribution company providing sales and transportation delivery of natural gas throughout most of the State of Florida and is a natural gas public utility subject to the Florida Public Service Commission's ("Commission") jurisdiction to establish rates and charges under Section 366.06, Florida Statutes.

Conservation Cost Recovery

2. The true-up amount for January through December 2025 was an over-recovery of \$9,802,836, including interest. (See Exhibit No. CTM-1; Schedule CT-1, Page 1 of 1, and Schedule CT-2, Page 1 of 3, filed May 1, 2026).

3. For the period January through December 2026, the total net true-up over-recovery is estimated to be \$3,257,750, including interest. (See Exhibit No. CTM-2; Schedule C-3, page 3 of 4).

4. For the forthcoming cost recovery period January through December 2027, Peoples projects its total incremental conservation costs to be \$25,660,908. Including the estimated true-up for January through December 2026, Peoples' total amount to be collected during the January

through December 2027 period is estimated to be \$22,403,158. In accordance with the rate design and cost allocation methodology set forth in Peoples' Commission-approved 2025 Stipulation and Settlement Agreement (Docket No. 20250029-GU), the required conservation cost recovery factors are as follows:
