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Dear Chairman of the Commission:

I am writing to encourage you to grant NC Real Estate Projects, LLC their requested \$15,000 connection fee to the HOMEBUILDERS to pay when they connect to the utility. My goal in encouraging this is to lower the burden on us, the current customers of the utility, to pay for the required improvements due to the Florida Dept of Environmental Protection mandate to lower nitrogen and phosphate levels.

I understand the BMAP law has requested the utility to lower nitrogen levels to less than 6, and phosphorus levels to less than 3, which is why the utility has applied to the PSC for recognition of the investment and allow for the utility to recapture the investment.

We understand that the Homebuilders have budgeted for the connection fees, and it is a normal part of doing business.

I feel it would be irresponsible of the Commission to diminish their budgeted cost and require the current customers to incur the largest portion of the investment recapture.
