On August 4, 2026, Duke Energy Florida (DEF or Company) submitted a request for confidential treatment of Document No. 04977-2026. The document contains confidential information from DEF's response to Florida Rising, Inc.'s supplemental response to request for production of documents, specifically No. 3. This document includes confidential contractual information in regard to a potential large load customer.

In its request for confidentiality, DEF asserts that disclosure of this information would result in harm. DEF asserts that the information contains proprietary confidential business information related to contractual documents in regard to a potential large load customer. Furthermore, DEF states that the information provided in Document No. 04977-2026 is treated as private and has not been publicly disclosed. The disclosure of this information would impair the competitive business of DEF and its affiliates.

Staff has reviewed the document and concurs with DEF that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would impair their ability to compete in the marketplace and contract for goods or services. Therefore, staff recommends the request by DEF for confidential classification of Document No. 04977-2026 be approved.
