 - c. Please provide copies of any tables, schedules, figures, workpapers, or other supporting information from the referenced 2026 true-up docket that were used directly or indirectly in the ECCR scenario analysis.
 - d. Please provide the monthly or yearly therm usage assumed (in therms-per-month or therms-per-year) to derive the baseline and proposed ECCR values in the ECCR scenario analysis.

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- e. Please provide the dollars-per-therm amount, conservation factor, or other factor(s) used to calculate the baseline and proposed ECCR values in the ECCR scenario analysis. Identify each factor separately and explain how each factor was applied.
- f. Please show the calculation(s) that led to the baseline and proposed ECCR values in the ECCR scenario analysis. Please provide sufficient detail to allow the calculations to be independently verified, including the applicable therm assumptions, rates/factors, and any other inputs in addition to those previously identified.
- g. Please provide, if available, the individual rebate program contributions to total baseline and proposed ECCR costs. For each rebate program, please identify the program name, applicable ECCR costs, and the percentage of total ECCR costs ascribed to that program. If such granular data is unavailable, please identify the reason and provide the most detailed program-level cost information available.
