2 CHAIRMAN SMITH: Moving to Item 11, Mr.
3 Bethea -- or sorry, Item 13. I need to read.

4 MR. BETHEA: Good morning Commissioners. I am
5 Terence Bethea with the Division of Economics on
6 behalf of Commission staff.

7 Item No. 13 is staff's recommendation to
8 address revised service availability charges and
9 policy for First Coast Regional Utilities in Duval,
10 Baker and Nassau Counties.

11 FCRU indicated that it was in its final stage
12 of design and construction cost components have
13 considerably changed. As a result, the utility
14 stated the revisions to the service availability
15 charges and policy are necessary to remain in
16 compliance with Commission rules and ensure the
17 appropriate costs are recovered through the
18 charges.

19 Staff determined the utility's revised service
20 availability charges and policy are reasonable and
21 within the -- and within the rules that govern
22 service availability. Staff recommends the revised
23 charges and policy be approved.

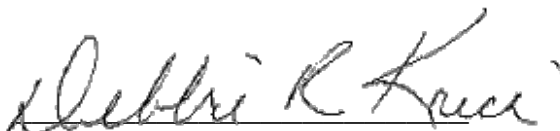
